One full-time or two part-time summer research assistants are needed to work on projects involving the Charter and regulatory enforcement. This research is primarily in the areas of constitutional, administrative, labour and employment law. The project focuses on assessing existing regulatory regimes against theoretical and empirical outcomes, and proposing modifications designed to better achieve legislative goals. The specific areas being examined are laws regulating collective employee representation, and formation of the employment contracts.

Responsibilities will include assisting with secondary research, preparation of literature reviews, some primary data collection, organizing research materials, and preparation of online surveys, exercises and similar documents.
